ALL State Meet Entry Fees Increase. This supercedes the board's decision not to increase Compulsory State Meet Fees this season.

Wisconsin State Meet Fees

- Level 4-6 \$50 \$53
- Level 7-10 \$60 \$65
- Level 3 \$25

Immediately effective, the Region has imposed a \$3 increase in all State Meet Head Taxes (\$2 now \$5). Rationale: \$3 of the \$5 Head Tax will go to the Regional Apparel Fund. Clubs will no longer be required to attend training camps to receive Regional apparel for Nationals.

Level 3 Sanctioned Competition. USAG-WI will conduct a Level 3 Program during the Optional season.

Level 3 USAG-WI Rules of Competition

- Qualification to State – Participation in at least 1 event in a USAG-WI sanctioned meet during the season.
- Entry Fees: Qualification Meets – Up to \$20; State Meet – \$25
- Awards – Event Ribbons, No AA Awards, Participation Award for all.
- Meet Officials – 1-judge panel (also at State)
- USAG Membership (may enroll for \$15 membership) www.USA-Gymnastics.org.

Region 4 Board Meeting Notes (Aug. 9, 2005)

State Meet Head Tax increased to \$5. 60% (\$3) goes to Regional apparel fund.

State Meet Fees for Levels 4-10 increase to maximum allowable fee of **\$65**. With the popularity of using outside facilities to host State Meets, this allowable fee increase is designed to help States fund the rental of outside facilities.

Regional Training Camps. Clubs no longer must attend training camps to receive Regional apparel for Nationals.

- Clubs still must participate in a training camp to be allowed into the high performance camp.
- If the high performance camp has less than 60 qualified registrants, qualified L-9/10's whose club did not attend training camp may register but at double the entry fee.
- Judges are allowed to attend all training camps for free.
- Coaches whose club did not attend a training camp may register for the high performance camp for \$100.
- Training camps will include L-7's who qualified to State Meet, immediately effective.
- Head clinicians that do both training camps receive \$500 bonus.
